Entering into Medical School in China

- Gaokao (高考): China's National College Entrance Examination.
 - Scored out of 750, with 90+ in subjects like Biology and Chemistry often required.
- Direct entry after high school: 5-6 year Bachelor's degree.
- Graduates with relevant degrees: 3-year program after obtaining Bachelor's.



Life in Medical School in China

- Pre-clinical Years (1-3): Basic sciences like anatomy, physiology, etc.
- Clinical Years (4-5 or 6): Hospital rotations in specialties like surgery, internal medicine.
- Graduation: Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or equivalent.



After Graduating from Medical School

- Residency (住院医师): 3-5 years, based on specialty.
 - Entry through the National Medical Licensing Examination (NMLE).
- Fellowship: For further sub-specialty training.
- Continuous Medical Education (CME): Mandatory for practicing doctors.
- Potential career paths: Practitioner, Researcher, Academician, etc.
